School Parking

In the last bulletin we asked if parents could please park in available parking spaces when dropping off and picking up children. This means that we do not "mix" cars and buses in the turning area, keeping children safe.

Outside of the school there is a good safe dropping off area to the left of the entrance. The right hand side has no parking markings some way down the road to allow buses in and out safely. Children dropped on the left hand side do need to cross the entrance to move onto the pathway into school, **pedestrians have the right of way here**, please ensure if you are coming into the school entrance in a vehicle you give way to them and allow them to cross.
