The weather has changed this week, but today it held to allow our all important enrichment activities to take place outside. Our children enjoy making the most of our grounds during social times and seem to have flawlessly made the switch to warm and weatherproof clothing to enable that to continue. The new shelter outside of the restaurant is getting good use this week and is much appreciated.

We have now completed 3 Year Ahead parent evening and next week we have our Careers Fair on Thursday, a flyer for this is attached. Our Open evening was well received, and it looks like we will be oversubscribed again next year in Year 7.

The Trust Review acknowledged the progress the school has made with behaviour and attitudes of our students. It is heartening to see the overall politeness, kindness and positive attitudes of our students acknowledged by an independent look at our school. Our uniform is amazing, and this was also recognised.

The efforts around recruiting high quality staff has also been acknowledged and the impact this will have on delivering high quality lessons in the school. Form time activities were seen as positive particularly around reading and numeracy. The team felt that "generally there was a positive climate for learning across the school", we do need to work with students on improving the quality of presentation in books.

The review agreed with our evaluations of what we need to work on this year, improving the Quality of Education through work on the curriculum and its implementation, literacy (including reading), and SEN provision. We had already started work on these areas and so we are well placed to see rapid improvement here.
