Non- Residential Trip Information

We are excited to finally present the brochure for the Summer Enrichment Week non-residential trips. Please look at the brochure accompanying the bulletin for further information.

The deadline for sign-up on these trips is **Friday 4th April.** At this point, you must have signed up your child via Arbor and paid the full amount (if applicable) for the trip.

We have deliberately kept trip costs down this year to make them more affordable. We are also offering an additional free trip (Musical Theatre) which we know will be well received by many students. There will also be a school curriculum offer for those students that do not sign up for any trips. We only offer this as a last resort because we want all our year 7-10 students to be signed up for an enrichment.
