Ixworth High School took part in the annual U15 boys rugby festival at Stowmarket RFC on Tuesday 26th November. There were 12 schools involved in a round robin style developmental competition.

Ixworth started in the lower section of the competition but quickly rose through the ranks with two dominant wins against Mildenhall and Breckland County. This pitted us against a strong OSA team who were slightly more experienced than our team. They passed the ball wide early to isolate our wings on two occasions, both resulting in breakaway tries.

We lost our next game against a well drilled Stowmarket team which placed us into a final game against our rivals, Stowupland.

Our strongest game of the afternoon meant we ran out 10-5 victors against a very strong Stowupland team. There were standout individual performances from Oscar C, Ben P and Charlie W, but the whole team should take credit for a fantastic afternoon of progressive rugby.
