### Admissions consultation 2026

Please find attached a copy of the draft Ixworth High School Admissions Policy 2026. There are no changes to the existing policy, but it seeks to clarify admission arrangements now that the school is part of Sapientia Education Trust. The consultation period for the draft policy is 6 weeks in accordance with paragraph 1.46 of the Schools Admissions Code 2021 and will start as of Friday 8 November 2024 and conclude on Friday 20 December 2024.
