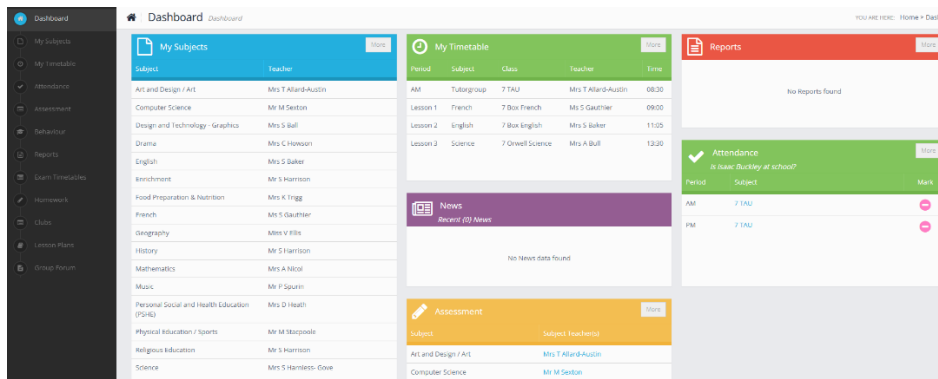

Having logged into Bromcom (school Id 16533) you land on this screen.



The dashboard is divided into several sections:

- My Subjects:** A list of subjects and their respective teachers.
- My Timetable:** A table showing the schedule for the current week, including periods, subjects, classes, teachers, and times.
- Reports:** A section for viewing reports, currently showing "No Reports Found".
- Attendance:** A section for checking attendance, currently showing "No Reports Found".
- News:** A section for viewing news, currently showing "No News data found".
- Assessment:** A section for viewing assessment results, currently showing "No News data found".

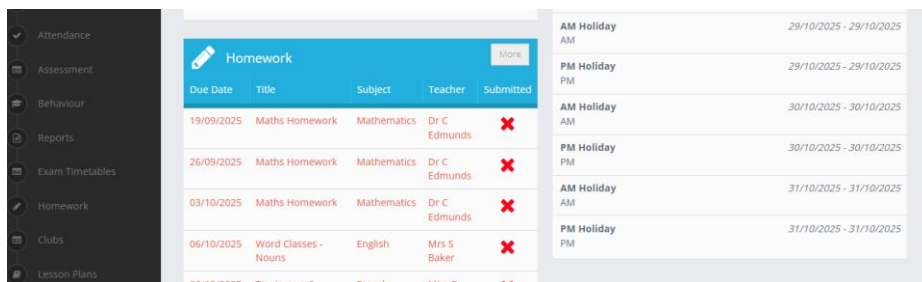

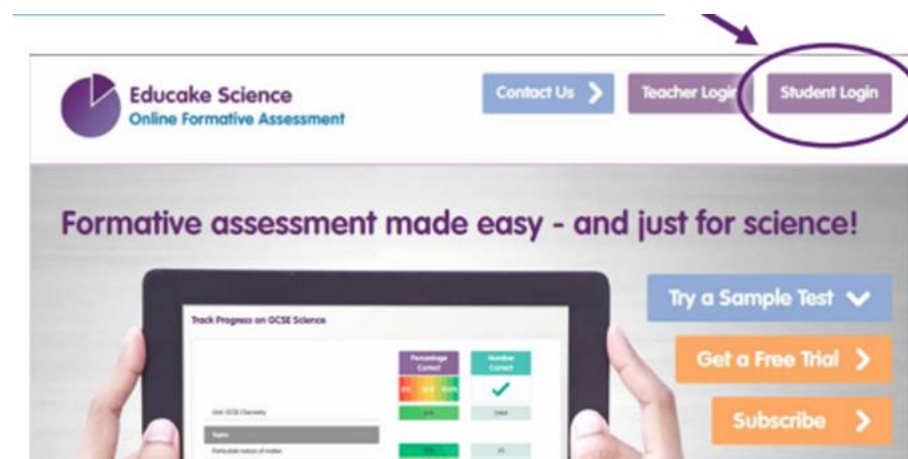

A Guide to Educake

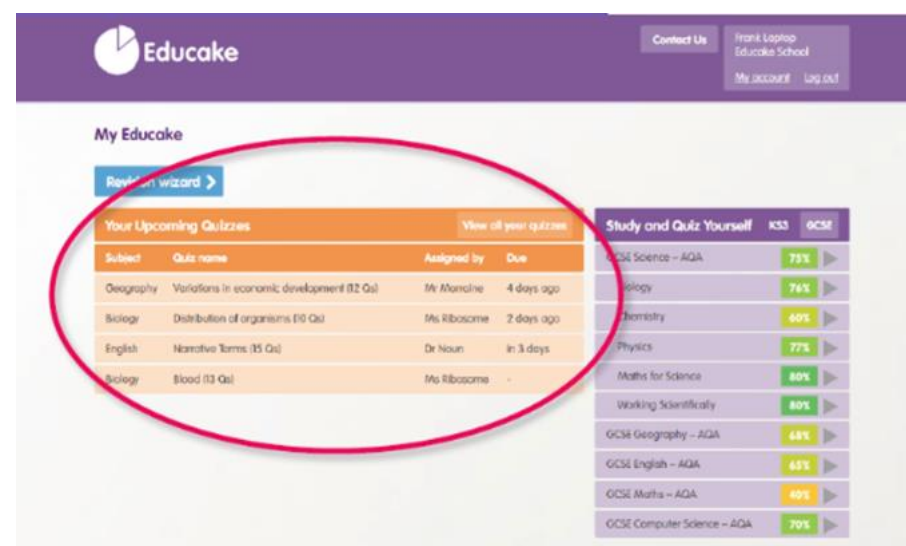
Go to www.educake.co.uk in a web browser, like Chrome or Safari

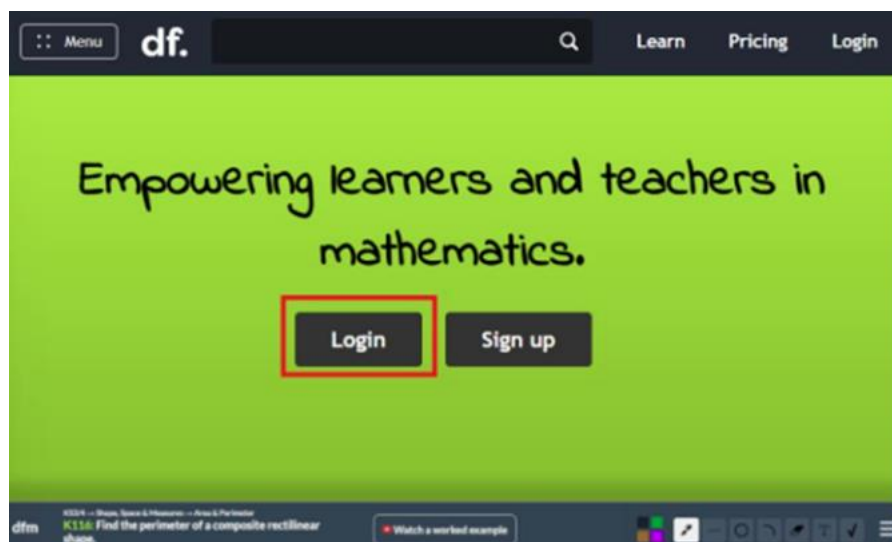

Access Dr Frost Maths via their website at: www.drfrost.org

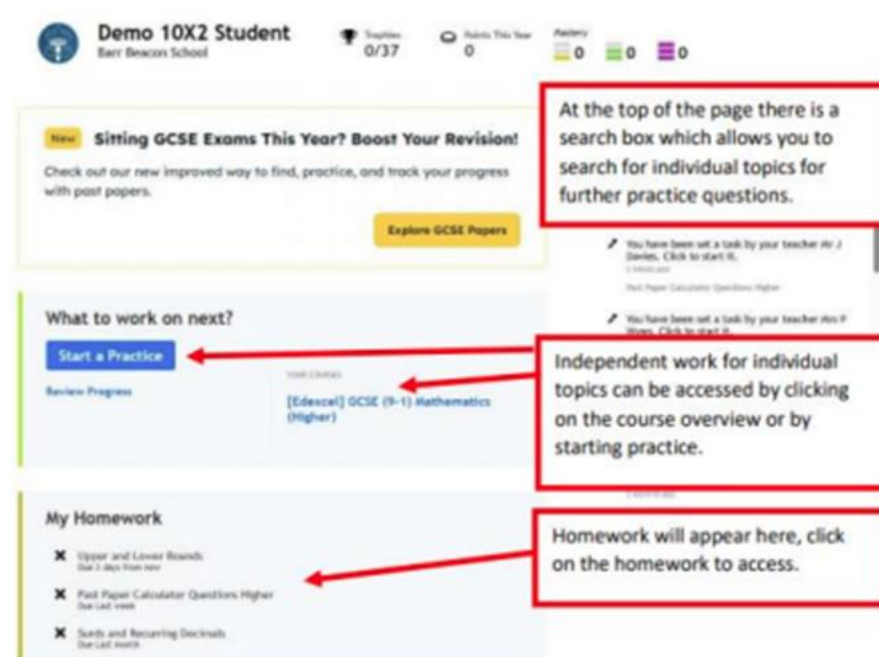
This will take you to their homepage, shown below. Once here, select the login option.

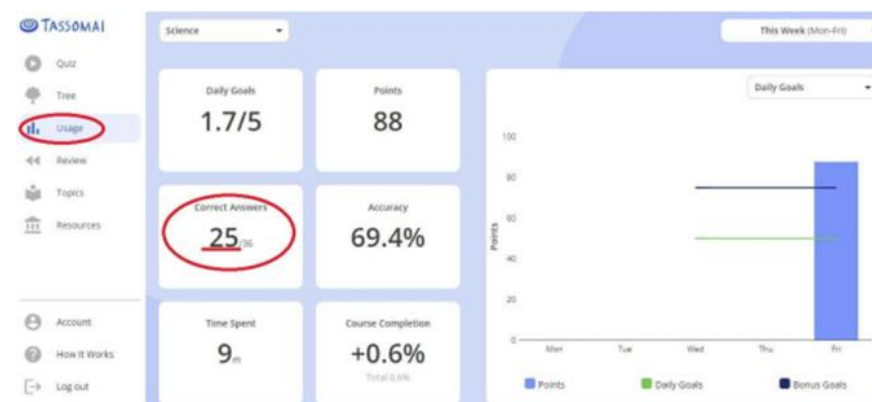


Enter your username (your school email) and your password (SmartWayToStudy)
