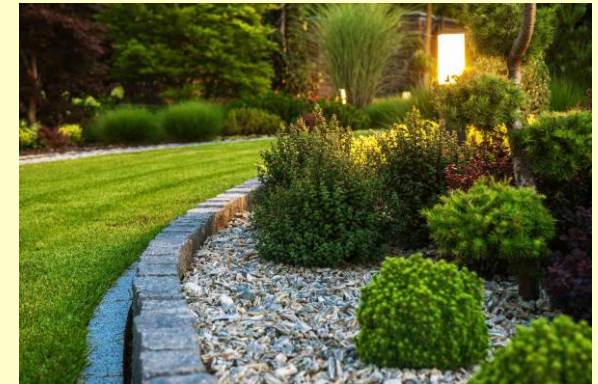
All students that undertake this must be willing to get their hands a little dirty!

Visit to Castle Acre Priory and Castle Rising – will complete interactive activities while there.

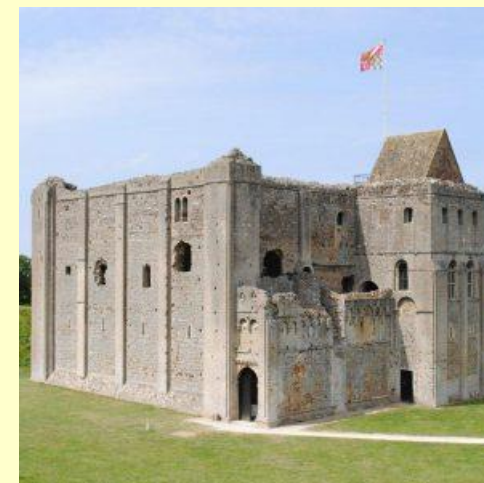
Tuesday 22nd July

Our visit to the Cambridge Science Centre will include the workshop “Go Ballistic” in which students will work collaboratively to fire projectiles – working out angles, distances and trajectories to make sure their cannonballs land on target. The workshop explores how scientific modelling and physical forces explain how human cannonballs land safely.

Friday 18th July: In school - A look at Creative Multimedia.

Monday 21st July & Tuesday 22nd July: A 2-day video workshop with a Film Education and Training Company. Full music video with practice session of verse and chorus, editing techniques, full tutorial of camera shots and techniques. Discuss music videos, why they are made, show examples, look at types of music videos.

How to edit, how to use equipment, shots, sizes and camera movement.

Split into groups of no more than 5 to film and edit a verse and chorus of a music video of their choice. Using this practice session to test skills and techniques before choosing another song to storyboard film, act & edit. Present all films at the end of the day.
